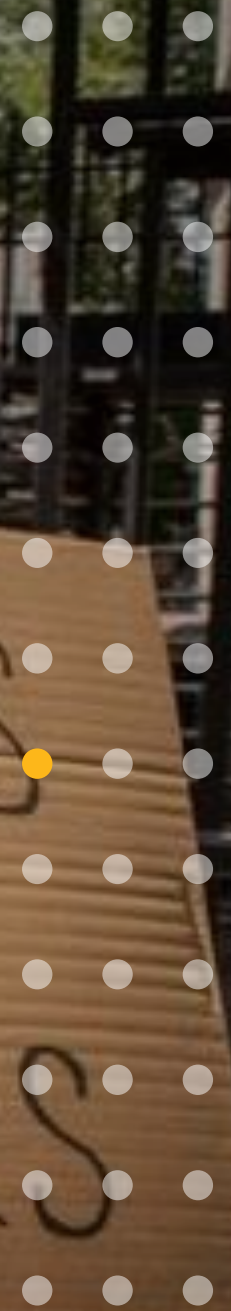
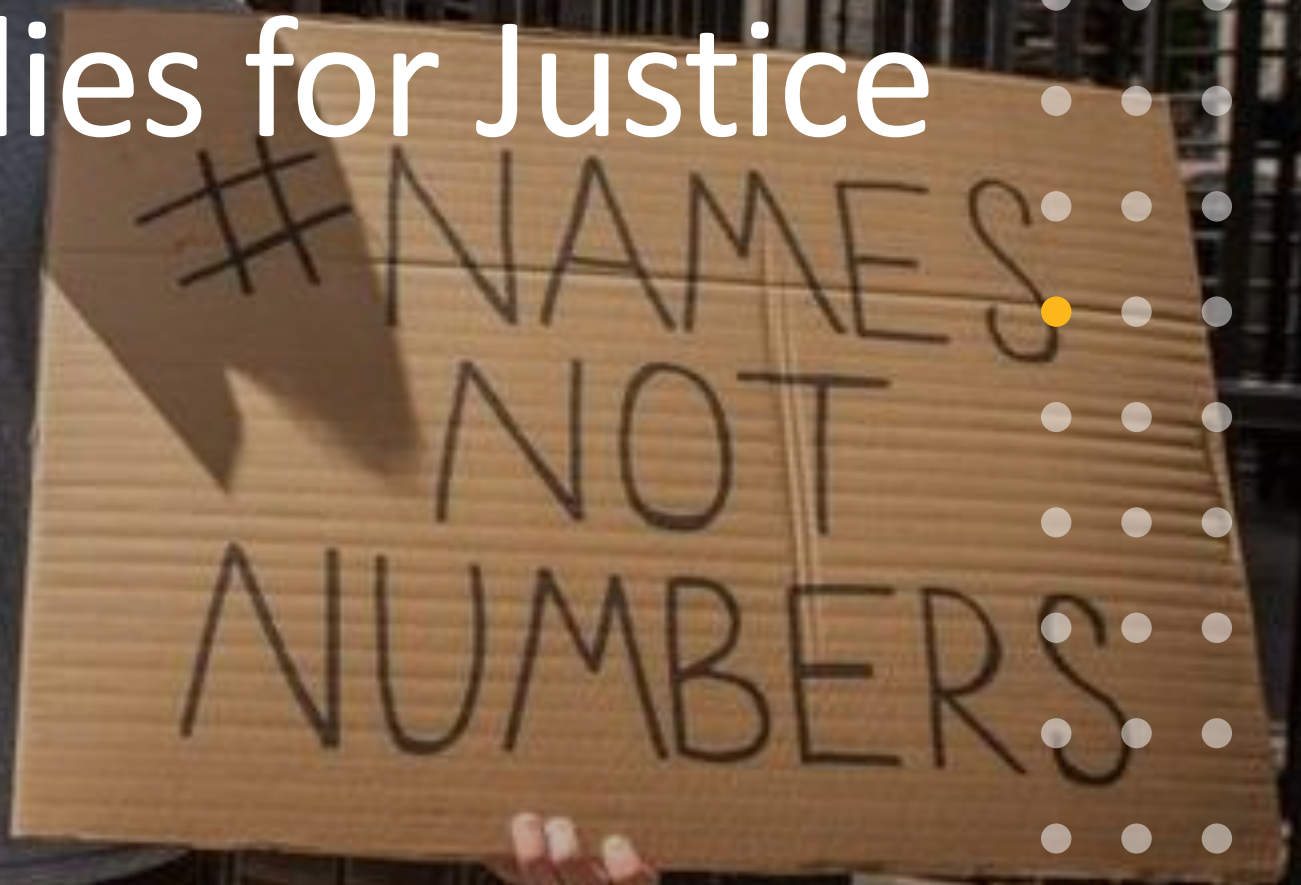

# Methodology: Overnight Polling Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> – Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> August

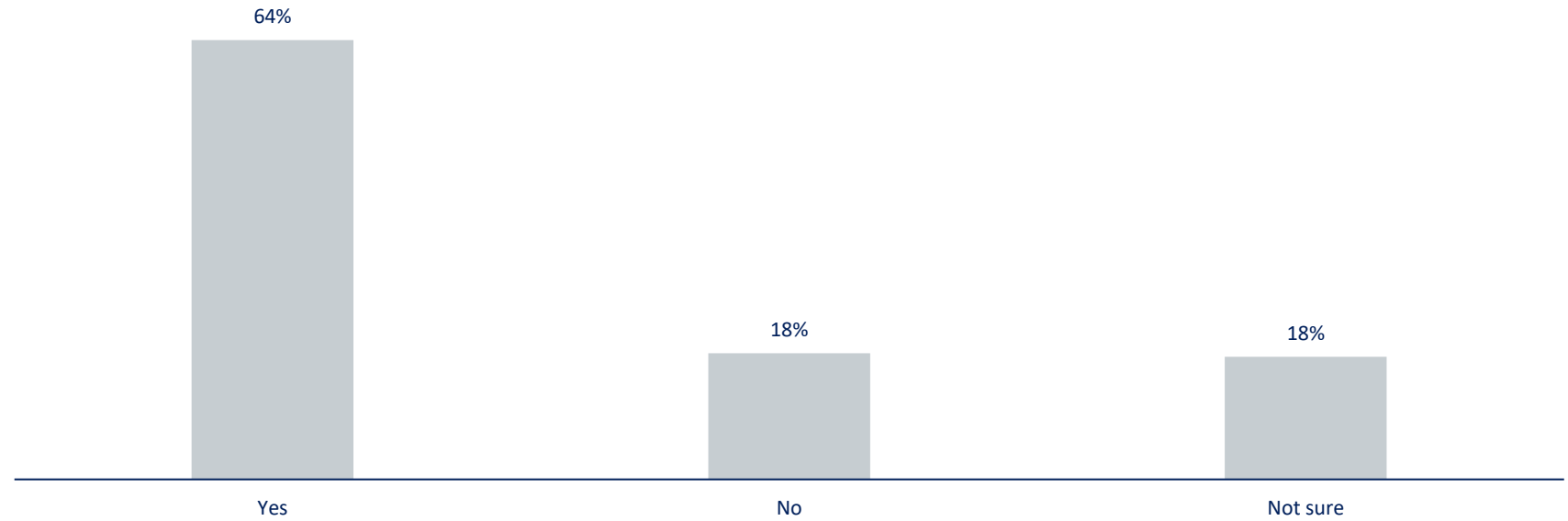
## Sample

# The majority think there will be another wave of COVID-19

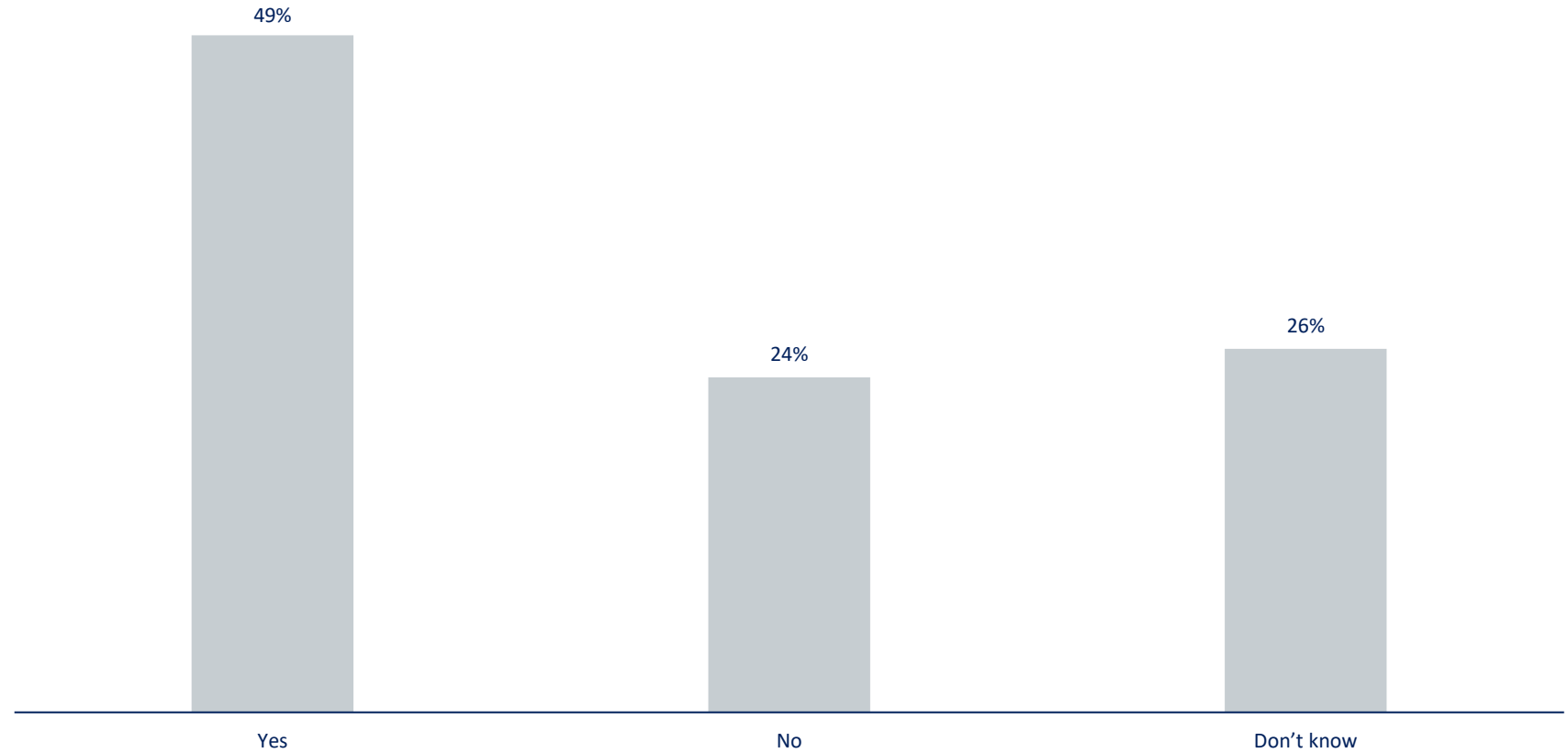
Do you think there will be another wave of COVID-19?

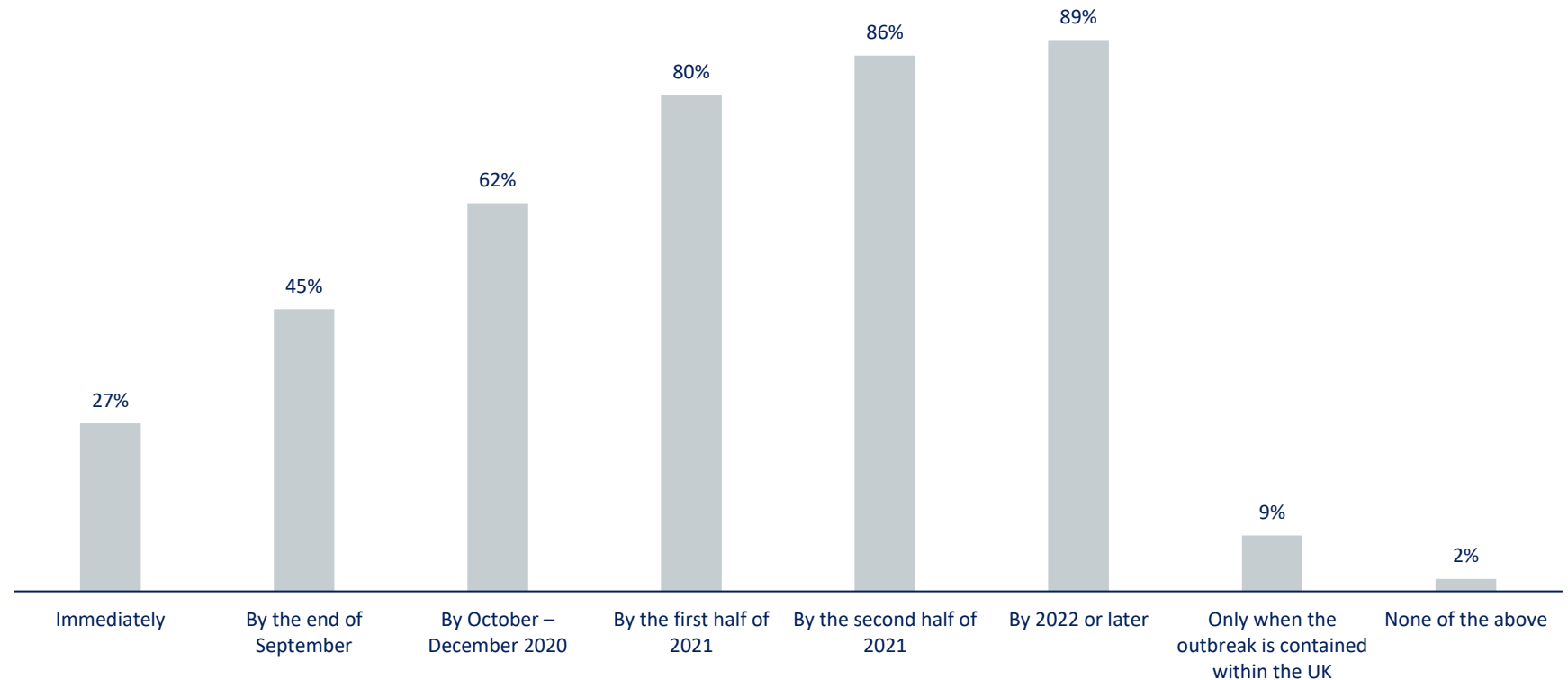

When do you think will be the right time for a 'statutory inquiry' be launched to learn the lessons from the handling of the coronavirus pandemic?

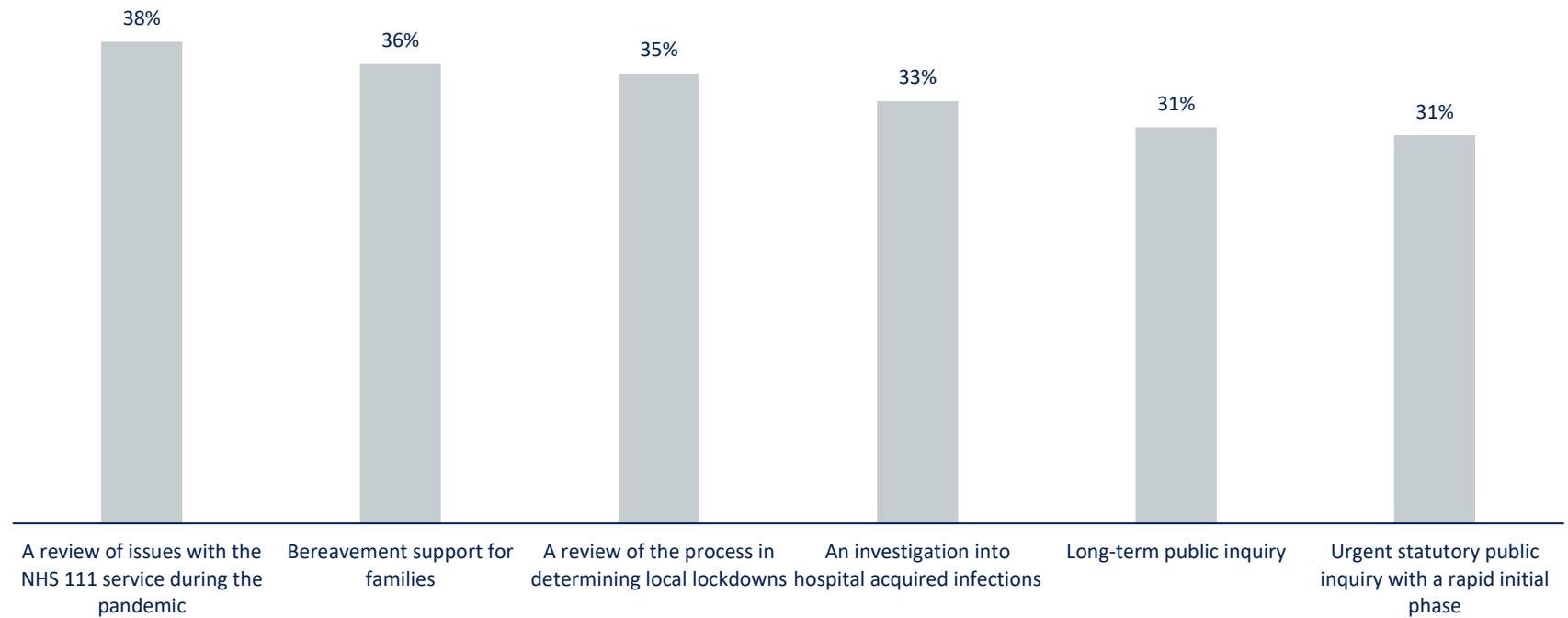
